Former Blind Elder gives more Testimonies



If you read our last newsletter, you may remember that a tribal elder, Joshua, was miraculously healed of blindness. We returned to visit him, and give him a Bible. I also gave him my reading glasses to help him in studying the Bible. He said “that he continues to walk around without any assistance.”

He gave a report that how on our last trip, as they asked us to pray for rain, Jacob gave them a word that he felt was from the Lord. The word was that God wanted **them** to pray for rain. God does not want them to think that He only hears the prayers of people that have white skin. He wants **them** to pray! After we left, Joshua remember the word from Jacob. About two weeks later he called others to join with him in prayer. In just a few days after they had prayed, it rained very hard for three days. This was very unusual since it was in the middle of their dry season! This rain turned all of Pokot green with new vegetation.
