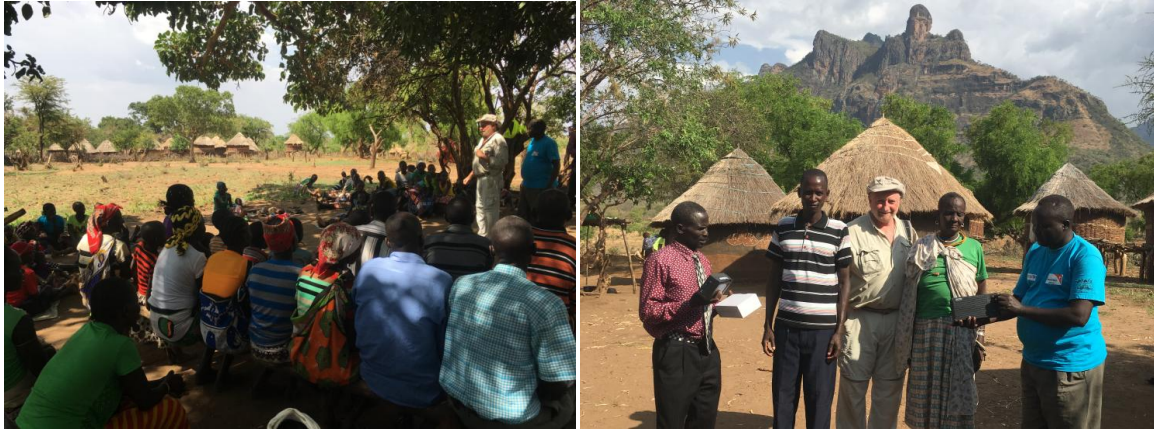


Pokot Now Update

(Feb-Apr 2017)



Preaching and helping to start a new church in a village in Uganda called Maurita. We also left behind two Proclaimers (Audio Bibles in the Pokot Language).



A good friend of mine, Mike Laughlin from Olathe, KS, visited me and helped to build a solar tower for our house. We also visited some villages and delivered beans.



This is the dry season and since some of the rains were very little this year, it quickly became a time of drought. The picture above is of the water in a local river a few months ago. Today, there is not even this much water. With help of donations from Christians from Taiwan and the US we were able to drill this well in the village of Lebock. Before the 500 people from the village had to walk miles for the water from the river and now the well can produce 5,000 liters an hour.



From delivering beans to our neighbors on the left, to driving four hours away to the village of Nakali, we have been able to buy and distribute over 3 tons of beans during this critical time. People now are without much food and the rains have not even come yet. They will eat some of these beans but will plant most of them. They still will have to wait till July to get a harvest of food!
