Lion tracks on the path



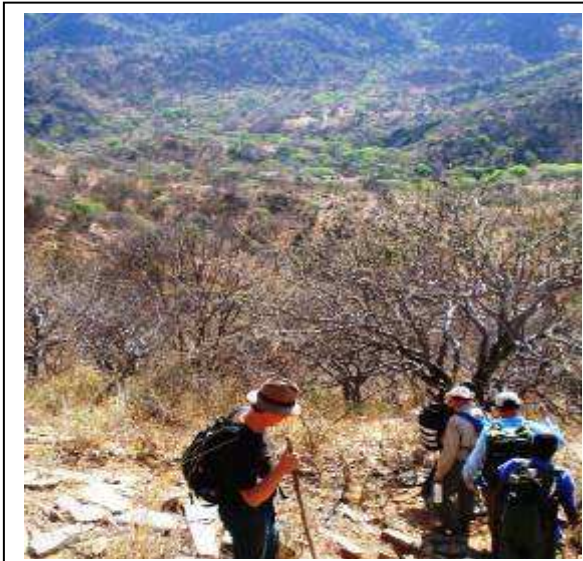
Running out of water in 115 degree heat

Days later traveling through dry river bed to reach a remote church



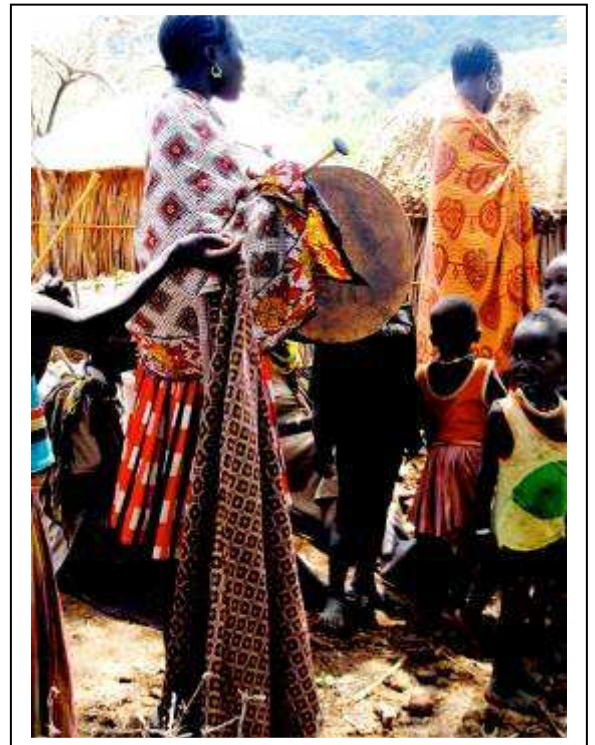
Passing through lion country



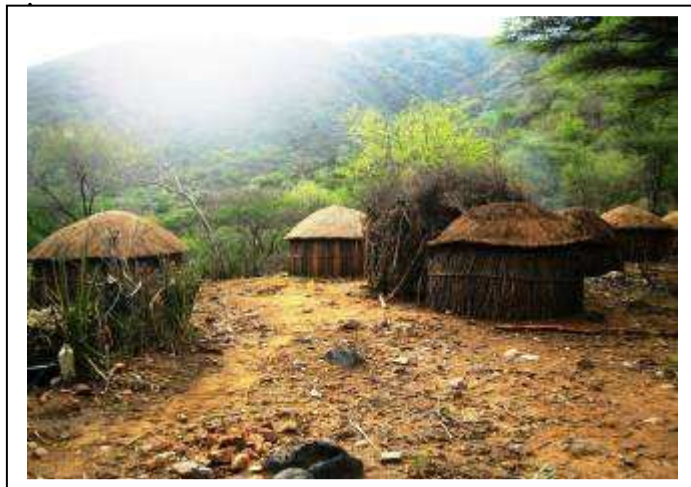
Hyena tracks along the path to the village
